We are passionate about the outdoors and the environment we live in, that is why we strive to have as little impact as possible.



When we do occasionally use bags they are made from plant based degradable materials.

We use plant based compostable hot and cold cups.

We recycle as much as is possible from the rubbish that is inevitably created.

To minimise plastic waste, we don't use bottled water for our Hydration Stations, instead fill our water drums from UV filtered tap water.

We believe that the environment that the event is created in and the people who are a part of it are what creates a great event, not noisy PA systems and infrastructure that requires generators, creating needless pollution. This means that our events are smaller and more informal than others, but we think that makes for a more friendly event that focuses on the camararderie, competition and appreciation of your surroundings.

Course markers are collected in as soon as possible after the event.

We are a small team so this can take a while! Any rubbish that has been dropped is cleared up, although we hope that no-one drops litter there is always the odd gel wrapper or top that may have dropped out of a bag.
